## PROJECT PRESENTATION

**Be in Europe** is a European project launched in the framework of the Erasmus+ programme dealing with adult education.

**Be in Europe** project proposes to foster active inclusion in Europe. To do so, the European partnership will work together until October 2020.

More precisely, **Be in Europe** aims to design and implement an effective training offer to reinforce not only the basic skills of these populations but also the key competences: it is a question of working on (psycho) social competences and intercultural competences. In addition, a "case study" is planned within the project in order to apply the lessons learned: migrants and enterprises will work together to achieve an intellectual production useful for each group, namely an accompaniment to the creation of activities/entrepreneurship by and for migrants with enterprises.

## 1ST STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING

**Be in Europe** project was officially launched in November 2018 in Lisbon, Portugal. During this steering committee meeting, the partnership discussed modalities about project implementation and development.

Partners organized working sessions on project future outcomes namely:

- (a) Migrant learning device to develop psychosocial competences (outcome 1 – O1),
- (b) Learning device for companies: mediation and intercultural competences (O2),
- (c) Support for the creation of activities/entrepreneurship (O3),
- (d) Collaborative platform "Be in Europe" (O4).

## NEXT STEPS AND SECOND STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING

Partners will be very active preparing:

1. Output 1: Migrant learning device
  - provision of the questionnaire, template and guidelines and administration of questionnaire about psychosocial competences to be improved;
  - writing of the overall report based on questionnaire results;
  - preparation of development of training modules.
2. Output 2: Learning device for companies
  - development of content for the theoretical approach;
  - template and guidelines to select mediation and intercultural competences;
  - preparation of content for the development of such competences.
3. Output 3: Support for the creation of activities / entrepreneurship
  - Inventory of the tools and methodologies to support creation of activities / entrepreneurship with a specific focus on migration;
  - provision of questionnaires, template and guidelines about migrants' competences and skills to develop entrepreneurship and (nascent) entrepreneurs from ethnic minorities.
4. Output 4: Development of the collaborative platform "Be in Europe" including *cliché* activity (work on stereotypes).

**Be in Europe** second steering committee will take place on June 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> 2019 in Sofia, Bulgaria.

Partners will carry on the project activities that they have started, namely:

1. Migrant learning device to develop psychosocial competences including curricula, theoretical framework, toolbox.
2. Learning device for companies: mediation and intercultural competences including definitions, methods, exercises, tools and learning units.
3. Support for the creation of activities/entrepreneurship.
4. Collaborative platform.
